Praying for the lost

2 Thessalonians 3:1-2

Praying for the lost

Matthew 6:9-10

Praying for the lost

Psalm 66:4-5

All the earth worships You
and sings praises to You;
they sing praises to Your
name. Come and see what
God has done: He is
awesome in His deeds
toward the children of man.

Father, I plead that the
people of this area will turn
to You and will praise Your
name. Let them see who
You are so they can praise
You.

Praying for the lost

Luke 24:47

And that repentance for the forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in His name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem.

Father, I plead that repentance and forgiveness of sins would be powerfully proclaimed in this house/area.

Praying for the lost

Psalm 95:6-8

Oh come, let us worship and
bow down; let us kneel
before the Lord, our Maker!
For He is our God, and we
are the people of His
pasture, and the sheep of
His hand. Today, if you hear
His voice, do not harden
your hearts, as at Meribah,
as on the day at Massah in
the wilderness.

Father, I pray that the people
in this home would hear Your
voice and that they would not
harden their hearts.

Praying for the lost

2 Corinthians 4:4

In their case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, to keep them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.

Father, I ask You to bind and remove Satan's work in this home and to open their eyes to the truth of the gospel

Praying for the lost

Romans 6:23

For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Father, I pray that the people in this home will receive the free gift of eternal life through Jesus Christ the Lord

Praying for the lost

Galatians 2:15-16

We ourselves are Jews by birth and not Gentile sinners; yet we know that a person is not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be justified.

Lord Jesus, I ask that each person in this home will not trust in himself/herself, but that they will completely trust in You as his/her Savior and Lord.

Praying for Needs

James 1:17

Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change.

Psalm 147: 3

He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.

Father, I pray that You would meet the emotional needs of the people in this place. Heal their emotional wounds.

Praying for Needs

Matthew 7:7

Praying for Needs

Mark 1:23-26

Praying for Needs

Acts 10:34

So Peter opened his mouth and said: “Truly I understand that God shows no partiality,”

Father, I pray that you would remove any racial or social barriers between the people in this home/area.

Praying for Needs

Psalm 82:3

Give justice to the weak and
the fatherless; maintain the
right of the afflicted and the
destitute

Romans 13:4

For he is God's servant for your
good. But if you do wrong, be
afraid, for he does not bear the
sword in vain. For he is the
servant of God, an avenger
who carries out God's wrath on
the wrongdoer.

Father, I pray that justice would
prevail, and that crime would
be annihilated in this area.

Praying for Needs

Ecclesiastes 2:24

There is nothing better for a person than that he should eat and drink and find enjoyment in his toil. This also, I saw, is from the hand of God.

Father, I ask that You would destroy poverty in this area. Grant economic growth and meet the financial needs of the people in this home/area.

Praying for Needs

Ephesians 5:22, 25, 6:1

Wives, submit to your husbands as to the Lord. -
Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave Himself up for her.

Matthew 11:28-30

Praying for Believers

Acts 1:8

Praying for Believers

Ephesians 5:18

Romans 5:5

Praying for Believers

John 15:4-5

Praying for Believers

Psalm 34:17-18

Romans 15:13
